MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT

The County of Brant hereby notifies all interested individuals and parties that the County is undertaking a Master Servicing Plan for the Community of Paris. The Master Servicing Plan will identify long term servicing strategies for water and wastewater servicing, stormwater drainage and transportation within the proposed Urban Settlement Area of Paris.

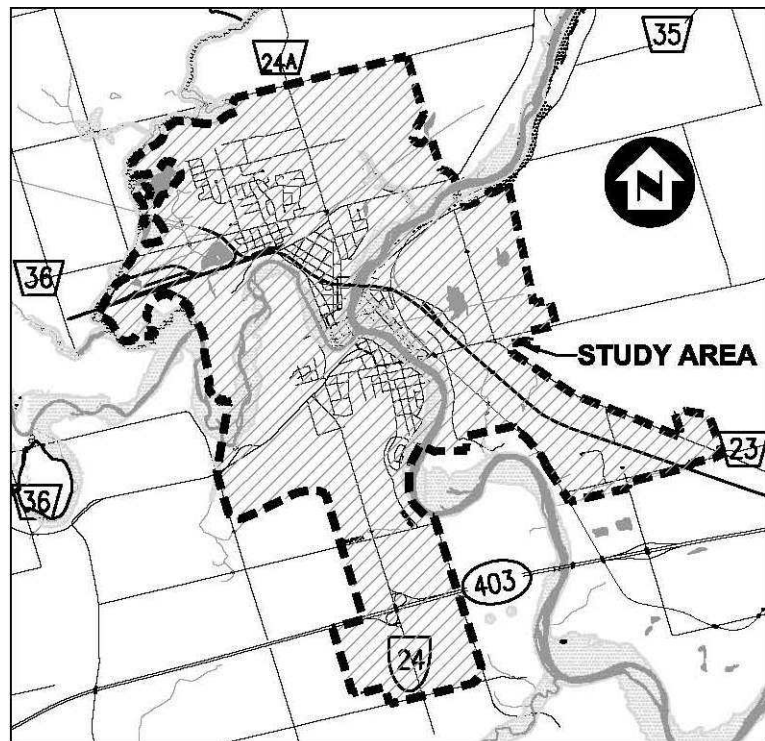
The Master Servicing Plan is to be prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process (October 2000, as amended in 2007).

Public Consultation will take place over the course of this study to receive public input and comments. It is anticipated that a Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held in winter 2010-2011 to present alternative servicing strategies and receive public input. Notice of the PIC will be published in advance of the meeting. At the completion of the planning process, the Master Servicing Plan will be filed for public review. Any works identified during the course of this project will be subject to further approval through the Class EA process and the Council of the County of Brant.
