



County of Brant By-Law 182-05 Community of Paris Heavy Truck Restriction



By-Law Enforcement

The County of Brant has updated By-law 182-05 to restrict Heavy Truck traffic from traveling through the Community of Paris, south of Silver Street and north of King Edward Street/Dundas Street East, excluding Heavy Trucks with an origin or destination in the community of Paris as defined by the Urban Settlement Boundary noted on the Map located inside this pamphlet.

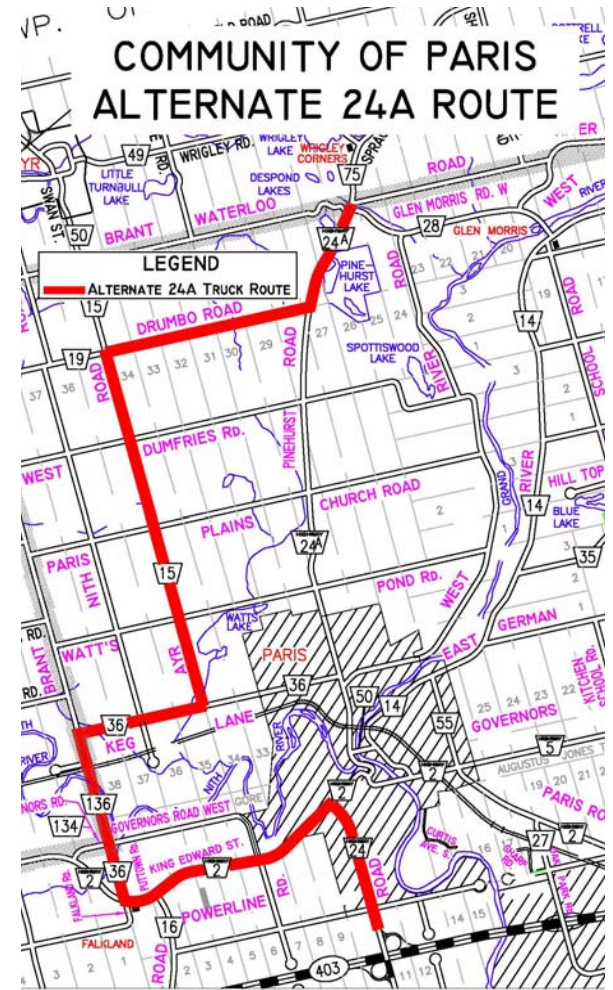
A **“Heavy Truck”** is defined as a vehicle with more than two axles and six tires, including a bus but not including a school bus, as defined in the Highway Traffic Act of Ontario, or a vehicle with an unloaded vehicle weight, as shown on the vehicle portion of the vehicle permit (Veh Wt.) exceeding 5,000 Kilograms(5 tonnes), but does not include a vehicle making a delivery to or a collection from a bona fide destination which cannot be reached via a highway or highways upon which heavy vehicles are not prohibited, having taken the most direct route to such said destination.



Enforcement

Persons found in contravention could face a fine of \$110.00 and 2 demerit points for the offence of Disobey sign Section 182(2) of the Highway Traffic Act.

The County of Brant recommends using the signed Alternative 24A Bypass Route, as indicated on the map below, to by pass the Community of Paris.
