Designing A Sustainable Waste Diversion Plan For Our Future

The County of Brant has drafted a waste diversion plan to provide for long term sustainable management of its waste.

County Council has affirmed its goal to meet and exceed the new Provincial waste diversion target of 60%. To achieve this goal, County Council has initiated a waste management planning process, and they invite you to participate in planning the solution.

The County held an initial public forum in January to explore:

- The public's vision and goals for a future waste diversion system;
- How to significantly improve waste reduction, recycling and composting; and,
- Criteria to evaluate waste diversion options.

A draft Waste Diversion Plan has now been developed. A second set of community meetings are intended to present the draft document and receive public comment. Public meetings to discuss Brant County's Solid Waste Diversion Plan are scheduled for the following dates:
