

Can We Help? & Canadian Tire JumpStart Programs

Applying for financial assistance for the County of Brant Recreation Programs

The County of Brant, Parks & Recreation would like to ensure that all children and youth of our Municipality have the opportunity to access recreation and leisure services. Assistance is available for program registration and material fees, as well as programs where a pass or punch card is available.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Any County of Brant resident who may feel unable to pay the full participation fee
- Assistance is available for eligible children and youth from 0 to 18 years
- Subsidies are limited to two activities or programs per participant per session depending on the funding available

HOW DO I KNOW IF I MIGHT BE ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE?

- The number of people in your family household
- Whether other assistance has already been provided for the current registration period
- Whether subsidy funds are still available for this session

To determine if your family might qualify for assistance please refer to the chart at the bottom of the other side of this pamphlet.

Note: Ontario Works and Ontario Disability recipients receive 100% funding with the appropriate documentation.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Please call to make an appointment with staff. They will tell you the necessary documentation that you will need to bring with you.

WHAT DO I NEED TO SHOW TO FIND OUT IF I QUALIFY?

When you request a subsidy, please provide the following information:

- A completed course registration form for your child or youth
- Verification of income from all of your family's sources of funding (samples of typical pay stubs, insurance benefits, cheque stubs from government assistance, income tax returns)
- Drug benefit card that identifies the children in your care or child tax benefit form.

HOW DO I PAY?

- Registrants must pay their portion of the program fees at the time of registration
- For County of Brant Parks & Recreation Programs, payment may be made by cash or cheque (made payable to the County of Brant). Debit is available at the Paris and Burford Offices.
