**Project Scope**-The County of Brant is progressively working towards building a new Twin Pad Facility to replace the 85 year old Syl Apps Arena and to provide an additional ice surface to better meet the community needs of the County of Brant. The facility will include: 2 NHL ice surfaces, 12 dressing rooms in total, including 2 barrier free dressing rooms, referees convener and alternate dressing rooms and two small community rooms and a community hall.

## Project Update:

- 14.8 million dollars was received through the Building Canada Fund, a Provincial/Federal infrastructure grant program.
- Fundraising Campaign has commenced to raise 3.5 million dollars from the Community
- Jay Wells has accepted the role of Honorary Chair of the Twin Pad Fundraising Campaign. Jay Wells is a native of the County of Brant and former NHL Hockey Player.
- Requested submissions from General Contractors for Pre-qualification for the project.

## Next Steps:

- Proceeding with preparing the contract documents and working drawings for tendering the construction.
- **Ground Breaking** is projected to be summer 2009.
- Proposed time frame indicates a **completion date** of August 2010.
