



BASEMENT FLOOD PREVENTION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

What is the Basement Flood Prevention Assistance Program?

On October 21, 2010, Brant County Council approved a grant program, offering reimbursement of the actual costs incurred by a residential property owner, for work undertaken to prevent storm water from flooding the basement of their residential dwelling. A grant of up to \$1,000 per property is available.

Who is eligible for the grant program?

1. You must be the owner of a residential dwelling within the County of Brant, and
2. The driveway on your property must be below the grade of the street, and
3. A catchbasin and gravity connection to the County storm sewer must be located at the base of the driveway to capture and convey water to the storm sewer

What kind of work may be eligible for assistance?

1. Installation of a back flow prevention valve on the private storm water connection
2. Alteration of driveway entrances to reduce overland flow to the base of the driveway

How do I determine what work is required to prevent or reduce flooding?

Contact a qualified professional to conduct a site assessment and recommend a solution

How do I apply for assistance?
