WOODSTOVES / FIREPLACES

- ❑ Permit applications to be completely filled out and signed
- ❑ Designer information 'Schedule 1' to be filled out.
- ❑ 2 copies of construction drawings drawn to scale (1:75 or 3/16"=1') :
 - Floor plans showing where appliance is to be located
 - Cross section
 - Age of structure
 - Information on existing ventilation (ie. HRV)
- ❑ Copy of woodstove / chimney manufacturer's specifications
- ❑ Payment of all applicable permit fees in full
- ❑ Chimney's for woodstoves must bear the designation 'ULC S629'
- ❑ Components for factory built fireplaces must exactly match the type and manufacturer specified in the fireplace's installation manual
- ❑ Used components must be inspected by building inspector **PRIOR TO INSTALLATION** and each component must have legible labels
