

Notice of Adoption of the Official Plan for the County of Brant

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the County of Brant passed By-law No. 183-10 to adopt the Official Plan for the County of Brant on the 7th day of September, 2010 in accordance with the provisions of Sections 17 and 26 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

The lands affected by the Official Plan are described as all the lands within the boundaries of the County of Brant and therefore no Key Map is provided.

THE PURPOSE of the Official Plan once approved or modified by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing (recognized as the approval authority), is to provide a new updated Official Plan for the County of Brant which reflects recent changes in legislation and Provincial, County and Municipal planning policies and directions for the County.

THE EFFECT of the Official Plan is to bring the County's Official Plan into conformity with current Provincial and County policies and provide a policy framework and planning tools for all land use planning decisions for the County of Brant up to the year 2031.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT any person or public body will be entitled to receive Notice of Decision from the approval authority if a written request to be notified of the Decision is made to the approval authority. The name and address of the approval authority to make the request is:
