Burford – June 23, 2011 - The County of Brant is implementing the recommendations from the Paris Bypass Class Environmental Assessment Study.

The recommendation included restricting Heavy Truck Traffic from traveling through the Community of Paris (South of Silver Street and North of King Edward Street/Dundas Street East), excluding Heavy Trucks with an origin or destination in the restricted area. The County of Brant Council updated By-Law Number 182-05 at their June 7, 2011 meeting to restrict Heavy Truck Traffic on streets within the Community of Paris as indicated on attached figure "Heavy Traffic – By Law 182-05 - Schedule D1".

The County anticipates to have all signage related to the Heavy Truck Restriction in place by early July and will begin enforcement thereafter.

The County will also be installing additional signage for the existing "Alternative 24A" bypass route and completing upgrades at the intersection of Puttown Road and County Highway #2 in conjunction with this project. The upgrades to the intersection of Puttown Road and County Highway #2 are anticipated to be completed by the end of 2011.
