Outdoor Recreational Amenities Re-opening

On May 20, 2021, the Province of Ontario announced the upcoming re-opening of many outdoor recreational amenities. With a beautiful forecast for the long weekend, we would like to remind you about what is open and closed as directed by the Provincial order.

Open:

- Parks
- Trails
- Benches
- Playgrounds
- Simply Grand Dog Park
- Public washrooms

As of Saturday, May 22, 2021, the following additional outdoor recreational amenities are open:

- Baseball diamonds
- Soccer and sports fields
- Tennis and pickleball courts (some locations are accessed by key)
- Basketball courts
- Skate parks
- Outdoor fitness equipment
- Boat and watercraft launches
- Picnic shelters and picnic tables

As of May 26, 2021, Disc golf will also re-open.

Paris and St. George Lawn Bowling Clubs will announce re-opening plans at a later date.

In order to use these amenities safely, you must maintain at least two (2) meters distance from any other person outside of your household. Team sports are not permitted at this time or other games that will result in individuals coming within two (2) meters of each other.

As well, as of May 22, 2021, an organized public event or social gathering with 5 people or less may be held outdoors. Please wear a mask when physical distancing may be difficult.
