

BY-LAW NUMBER 84-20

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT

To amend Bylaw 72-20, being a bylaw to require the wearing of face coverings in enclosed public places in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, known as the "Face Covering By-Law".

WHEREAS on July 14, 2020, Council approved and enacted By-law 72-20, being a bylaw to require the wearing of face coverings in prescribed, enclosed public places in response to the COVID-19 pandemic known as the "Face Covering By-Law";

AND WHEREAS Section 18 of By-law 72-20 states *"this By-law shall expire on Wednesday, August 12, 2020, unless otherwise extended by Council"*;

AND WHEREAS on July 31, 2020, the Acting Medical Officer of Health for the Brant County Health Unit advised the County of Brant Emergency Operations Centre of her continued support for the enactment of a by-law requiring face coverings in indoor public spaces for the protection of the health, safety, and well-being of County of Brant residents;

AND WHEREAS Council desires that By-law 72-20 be extended for a period to continue to protect the health, safety, and well-being of County of Brant residents.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. That Clause 9 of By-law 72-20 be amended to include the following additional clause:
(q) "Churches / places of worship, provided the congregation has and follows an effective COVID mitigation / risk reduction plan reviewed and approved by the County of Brant."
2. That Clause 18 of By-law 72-20 be amended to read "This By-law shall expire on Wednesday, October 28, 2020, unless otherwise extended by Council."

READ a first and second time, this 11th day of August, 2020.

READ a third time and finally passed in Council, this 11th day of August, 2020.
