

Notice of Public Information Centre No. 1

Grand River Street North Corridor Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study

Introduction

The County of Brant has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for transportation network improvements to Grand River Street North between Watts Pond Road and St. Patrick Street. Based on feedback received by the public at the Community Café event, the study area has been expanded south to William Street and along Paris Links Road. The proposed improvements will address the transportation needs identified in the Transportation Master Plan and accommodate all road users, while supporting the existing institutions, businesses, and planned development growth.

Study Process

The Grand River Street North Class EA is being conducted as a Schedule 'C' project under the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2007)*, as amended in 2015. The Study will complete all necessary phases of the Municipal Class EA to receive environmental clearance for construction.

Public Consultation

The County wishes to ensure that anyone interested in this study has the opportunity to be involved and provide input. Three Public Information Centres (PIC) are being held to provide information and receive feedback from the public and stakeholders. At this open house style meeting, the County will present the background information and the preliminary improvement alternatives, and receive public comments. The PIC will include a **formal presentation starting at 6:30 pm**. Information on the project to date is available on the County of Brant website.

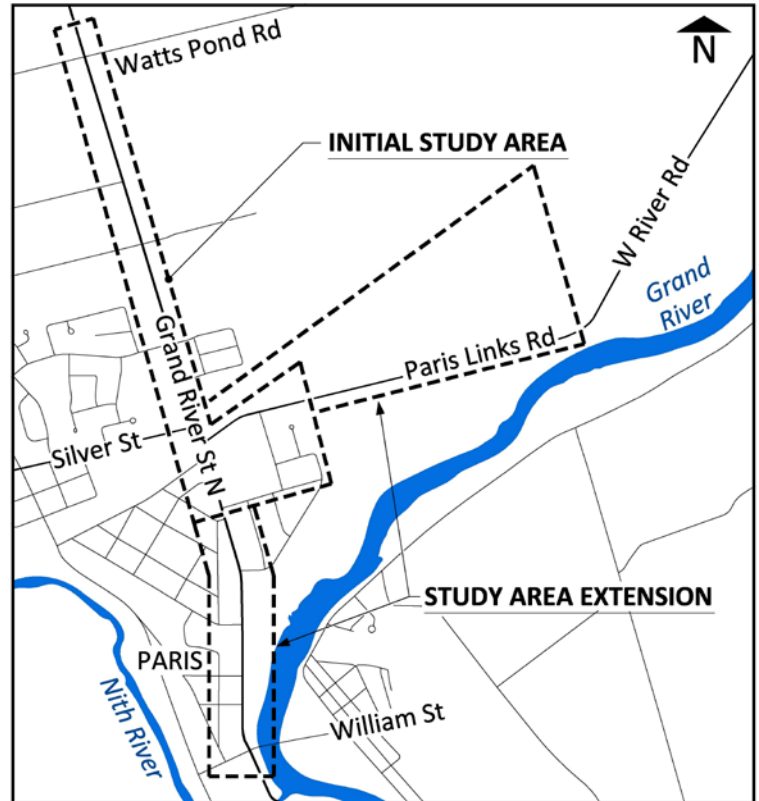
The first Public Information Centre is scheduled for:
