

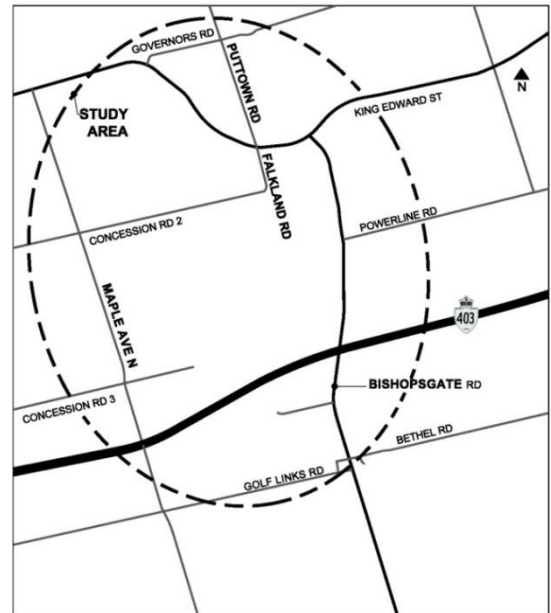


COUNTY OF BRANT NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE No. 4

Harmonized MTO Provincial Transportation Facility and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for a Proposed New Interchange at Bishopsgate Road/Highway 403

The County of Brant, through their consultant BT Engineering, is conducting a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for the planning of a new interchange at Bishopsgate Road and Highway 403 and the realignment of Bishopsgate Road to Puttdown Road through Falkland. The purpose of the project is to accommodate truck traffic that will be generated by the planned expansion of aggregate site operations. The project will also improve access for emergency vehicles and serve future development in the Southwest Paris Settlement Area. The Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) has been consulted throughout this study.

THE PROCESS

The Study is being completed as a Harmonized Class Environmental Assessment for the MTO Class Provincial Transportation Facilities and Municipal Class Environmental Assessments in accordance with requirements of both the MTO Provincial and the Municipal Class EA processes. This Harmonized Class EA process will include defining the operational issues for improvement, documenting existing environmental conditions, public and review agency consultation, evaluation of alternatives, impact assessment of proposed alternatives, and identification of measures to mitigate adverse impacts. Further notification throughout this Harmonized Class EA process will be provided to the public and all stakeholders who express interest and to those who participate in the consultation process.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The County wishes to ensure that anyone interested in this study has the opportunity to be involved and to provide input. At this Public Information Centre (PIC), the County will present:

- The Recommended Plan for the proposed Highway 403/Bishopsgate Road interchange;

- The Recommended Plan for the realignment of Bishopsgate Road to Puttoun Road through Falkland; and
- Mitigation plans.

The PIC will include a formal presentation starting at 6:00 pm.
