



Notice of Public Information Centre No. 1 And Study Commencement

Harmonized Provincial Transportation Facility and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Proposed New Interchange at Bishopsgate Road and Highway 403

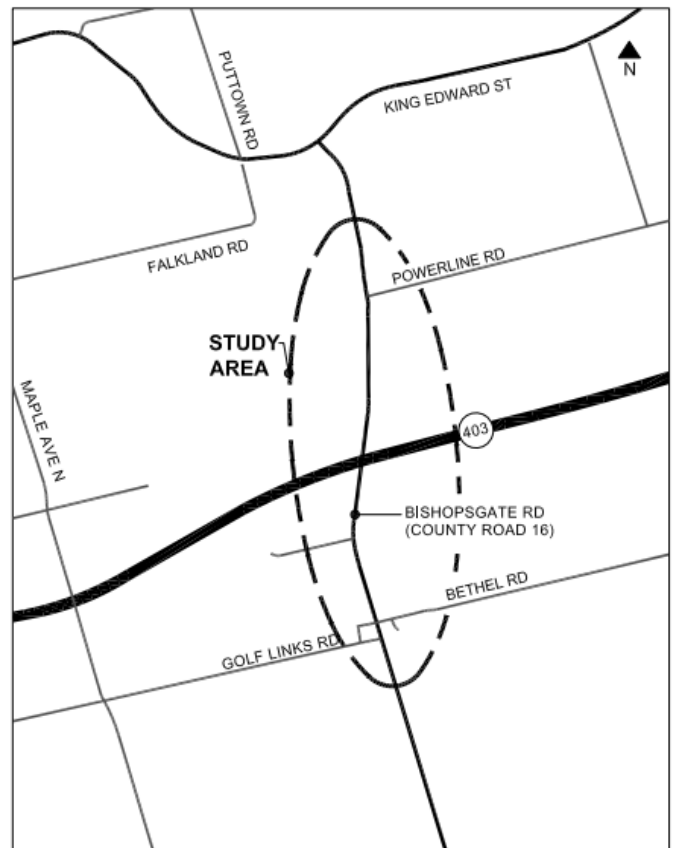
The County of Brant, through their consultant BT Engineering, has initiated a Harmonized Provincial Transportation Facility and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for the planning of a new interchange at Bishopsgate Road and Highway 403 located southwest of Paris. The Ontario Ministry of Transportation will be consulted throughout this study. The purpose of the project is to accommodate truck traffic that will be generated by planned expansion of aggregate site operations. The project would also improve access for emergency vehicles and serve future development in the Southwest Paris Settlement Area. As such, several alternatives will be considered to accommodate current and future traffic volumes and provide efficient transportation service on the Bishopsgate Road corridor.

Study Design

A draft Study Design is also available on the County of Brant website <http://www.brant.ca/>. The Study Design describes the project scope, study approach, need and justification of the study, study process and preliminary design criteria.

The Process

The Study is proceeding as a Harmonized Provincial Transportation Facility and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment in accordance with the requirements of both the Provincial Transportation Facilities Class EA and the Municipal Class EA processes. This Harmonized Class EA process will include defining the operational issues for improvement, documenting existing environmental conditions, public and review agency consultation, evaluation of alternatives, impact assessment of proposed alternatives, and identification of measures to mitigate adverse impacts. Further notification throughout this Harmonized Class EA process will be provided to all stakeholders who express interest as a result of this Notice of Commencement and to those who participate in the consultation process.



Public Consultation

Members of the public and review agencies are encouraged to provide input on the studies. Four Public Information Centres will be held to provide information and receive feedback from the public. The first meeting will be held on November 18, 2015 to introduce the project, present an overview of study activities, and gather initial feedback from the public and review agencies.
