Cedar Street, Paris**

The County of Brant invites you to engage with us as we evaluate ways to improve stormwater drainage on Cedar Street in Paris. The study will be completed as a Schedule 'B' project in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process (Municipal Engineers Association, June 2000, as amended in 2015) since some of the alternatives consider the use of lands that are not part of a municipal servicing corridor. The Class EA will evaluate various alternatives to responsibly manage stormwater runoff in the Cedar Street drainage area. The preferred stormwater management improvements will be completed when the road is reconstructed, which is currently planned for the 2021 construction season.

All information for this project will be posted on the County's website at www.brant.ca/CedarStreetEA. A recorded presentation will be posted ahead of the meeting date so that interested community members can view the information and submit questions ahead of the virtual public meeting. A comment sheet, preliminary design drawings, drainage report and a link to sign up for the virtual public meeting will also be posted at this location on the County's website.

Public consultation is important for the success of this project. We're interested in receiving your comments. A virtual public meeting is planned to present the project, an evaluation of alternatives and the recommended preferred alternative. Although stormwater management on Cedar Street is the subject of this Class EA, the County would also like to receive feedback related to the planned road reconstruction and sidewalk. Preliminary design drawings will be available for viewing at the website location noted above. Road improvements and water/wastewater servicing extensions are considered Schedule A/A+ projects, which are pre-approved under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA).
