

BY-LAW NUMBER 36-18

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THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT

To amend By-law Number 121-08, the Sign By-Law for the County of Brant, as amended (Community Improvement Plan Approved Signage)

WHEREAS the County of Brant initiated a review of its Sign By-law to ensures currency, correct identified errors in mapping and text, and clarify interpretative provisions;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act empowers a municipality to pass by-laws prohibiting the erection, location and use of signs, except as set out in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS this by-law is in conformity with the Official Plan of the County of Brant;

AND WHEREAS County of Brant Council approved amendments to the Sign By-law to exempt signage which has obtained approval through the Community Improvement Plan process from this by-law;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. **THAT** Section 4 General Provisions, is hereby amended by adding the following:
 - 4.8 Any signage which has obtained approval by Council through the Community Improvement Plan process (CIP) shall be exempt from this By-Law and the requirements therein.
