



Paris Water, Wastewater and Stormwater Master Servicing Plan Notice of Public Information Centre

Why is a study needed for Paris' Water, Wastewater and Stormwater?

The County of Brant is undertaking a Water, Wastewater and Stormwater Master Servicing Plan (MSP) for the community of Paris. Paris is the largest urban center within the County and has experienced growth in recent years. Paris is projected to continue to grow. It is necessary to carefully plan future infrastructure needs that will be necessary to support the full buildout of the Paris Settlement Area. This study will provide direction on how to efficiently provide long term servicing strategies for water and wastewater servicing and stormwater drainage service to the full buildout of the Paris Settlement Area.

The Process

The Paris Master Servicing Plan will be completed in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process for Master Planning (MEA, June 2000, as amended in 2007 and 2011). The study is being undertaken based on Phases 1 and 2 of the Class EA processes for Master Plans.

How can I Participate in this Study?

Public consultation and getting feedback is an important component of this project. The County invites agencies, interested stakeholders and residents to participate in this planning process and learn more about the Paris Water, Wastewater and Stormwater Master Servicing Plan through attendance at a Public Information Centre (PIC). The PIC will focus on the water, wastewater, and stormwater servicing concepts and preliminary preferred solutions. Representatives from both the County of Brant and the consultant will be present at the PIC to answer questions and discuss the study progression to date.
