

NOTICE OF END OF PUBLIC INPUT FOR THE PARIS CENOTAPH

Two new stones bearing the names of the Paris Veterans will be added to the Paris Cenotaph during the summer of 2018.

Public input has been sought to confirm names of the War dead who were never added to the Brant County War Memorial and the correction of some names that were misspelled.

The Royal Canadian Legion Branch 29 (Paris) along with the County of Brant are requesting that any additional names or the correction of spelling of Paris Veterans names who were killed or died while in service during WWI and WWII, be submitted by March 12, 2018 at 4:00 p.m.
