County of Brant Opens After School Program Registration

County of Brant, ON – With school just around the corner, the County of Brant is pleased to announce it will offer After School Programs. Registration opens beginning August 25, 2020 at 6:00 pm. Please check www.brant.ca/AfterSchool for a listing of each schools' registration date and time.

“We are very excited to welcome our friends back to the After School Program,” said Stacey Ellins, Acting Director of Recreation and Community Development with the County of Brant. “With careful guidance from the Brant County Health Unit, we will offer After School Programs with safety as our top priority. We have worked closely with the Brant County Health Unit to create a variety of protocols to support a safe setting and provide much needed support to working caregivers.”

In accordance with the Brant County Health Unit and the local schoolboards, new guidelines, health and safety measures and programming have been developed for the safety of participants and staff. Additional hand washing and cleaning practices will also be in place.

“In order to promote a safe and fun environment, we will have fewer children in each group and we will focus on outdoor programming, weather permitting,” said Ellins. “We will have a number of proactive measures in place such as contact tracing, promoting physical distancing in our activities and the use of face masks for children, when required.”

The new safety protocols will be provided to families prior to the start of program.

“We will continue to work closely with the local health officials and schoolboards to assess the safety of offering the After School Programs,” said Ellins.
