- Meet with coaching staff periodically to check in to see how the team is and if there are any matters
- Be available to speak to parents to listen to their ideas, concerns and develop camaraderie.
- Network with parents and make yourself available to answer their questions and resolve any issues
- Consult with PSC convenor for advice and support in dealing with any serious matters.
