This week’s trip day is Wednesday and we are going to Pinehurst Conservation Area in Ayr! Please send your camper in their bathing suit (under their clothes) and with comfortable clothing and shoes, water, sunscreen and, litter less lunches and snacks.

Campers will have the opportunity to swim and go on paddleboats while at Pinehurst, please be aware that we will be bringing a lifeguard with us to supervise the water portion of the day. All campers that want to go on the paddle boats have to have a filled out waiver signed by their parent, the waivers will be on the front desk at camp and are due Wednesday morning before the trip. Campers without a signed waiver will not be able to go on the paddles boats but will enjoy other activities like swimming and playing in on the beach. We ask that campers do not bring any spending money with them on the trip. Every camper will receive a camp t-shirt to wear on the trip, after the trip all campers will return their t-shirt, if you would like your child to keep their t-shirt you can purchase one at camp for \$7.00.
