

Background:

The proposal for a new Cainsville Community Centre first came to Council in 2015, as the current Cainsville Community Centre was aging and no longer met capacity needs for user groups. Through public input, a more modern and larger community centre was designed that will be able to host community events and serve as a gathering place for not only the Cainsville community, but the County of Brant as a whole.

In 2017, the County of Brant purchased 8.9 acres of property at the corner of Ewart Avenue and County Road 18 to accommodate a both a Community Centre and a new Fire Station for the Cainsville area.

Strategy:

The new Cainsville Community Centre will be located at 15 Ewart Avenue and is designed to be multi-functional facility to accommodate meetings, community events, private family functions, recreation programs and social support services.

The Community Centre will be approximately 9,000 square feet and includes a 3,820 square foot community hall, a 710 square foot meeting room, spacious lobby, an 1,140 square foot outdoor covered patio and other supporting amenity spaces.

The facility includes sustainable design features such as energy efficient fixtures/equipment, a well-insulated building, as well as, an electric car charging station.

A fundraising campaign will be launched in the future to help offset the total building costs.

Timeline and Implementation:

The Tender has been awarded to Reid and Deleye Contractors.

Groundbreaking for the construction took place on Friday, November 5, 2021.

Construction is expected to be completed by mid-2023.
