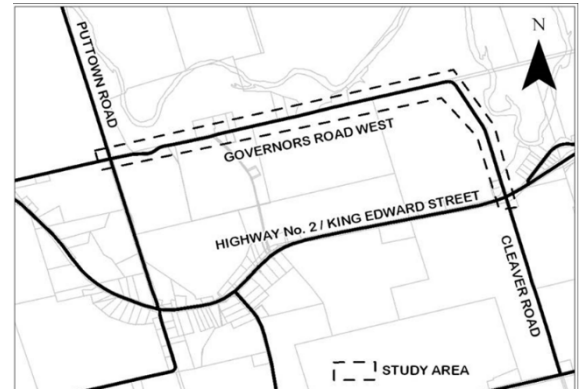


Governors Road West Class Environmental Assessment

The County of Brant has completed the Governors Road West Class Environmental Assessment (EA). This project examined how to improve the road network and connection between Governors Road West (from Puttawn Road to Cleaver Road) and Cleaver Road (from King Edward Street to Governors Road West). The recommended improvements include a new road alignment and re-opening the existing road that was temporarily closed once the Lafarge gravel pit is no longer in use.



The Governors Road West Class EA was completed as a Schedule 'B' project under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2000), as amended in 2015. The Study has completed all necessary phases of the Municipal Class EA and is documented in the Environmental Study Report (ESR). Following the public review period, if there are no objections, the project will receive environmental clearance for construction.

The ESR will be available on public record for a public and agency review period from March 8 to April 23, 2021 at the following locations. Please note, due to COVID-19, call 519.44BRANT for an appointment:

The ESR will also be available for viewing on the County of Brant's website, www.brant.ca/plans from March 8, 2021.

If there are any concerns regarding the project that cannot be resolved in discussion with the County, a person or party may request, in writing, that the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. Requests, with reasons, may be received by the Minister and Director of the Environmental Assessment and Permissions Branch of the MECP (at the addresses noted below) prior to April 23, 2021. The request must also be copied to the County's Project Manager identified below.
