Please note the County of Brant has completed the Paris Water, Wastewater and Stormwater Master Servicing Plan Study. GM BluePlan was retained by the County of Brant to complete the Master Servicing Plan. The objective of the study was to integrate the latest Provincial Growth Plan to develop an infrastructure plan that supports the full buildout of the existing Paris Settlement Area.

The objective of the Master Servicing Plan update is to comprehensively document the development, evaluation, and selection of the preferred water, wastewater, and stormwater servicing strategies to meet the servicing needs of existing and future development to Settlement Area Boundary Buildout.

The Water, Wastewater and Stormwater Master Servicing Plan has been completed in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Engineers Association Class Environmental Assessment process for Master Planning (June 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015). The study is being undertaken based on Phases 1 and 2 of the Class EA processes for Master Plans.

The Master Servicing Plan update will be available on public record for a 45-day public and agency review period from November 24, 2020 to January 8, 2021 at the following locations by appointment:

- Paris Customer Service Office, 66 Grand River Street North, Paris

The Master Servicing Plan update will also be available for viewing on the County of Brant's website, www.brant.ca/EA from November 24, 2020.

If there are any concerns regarding the project that cannot be resolved in discussion with the County of Brant, a person or party may request, in writing, that the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. Requests, with reasons, may be received by the Minister and Director of the Environmental Assessment and Permissions Branch of the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks using the Part II Order Request form noted below, within 45 days of this notice, prior to January 8, 2021. The request must also be copied to the County's Project Manager identifies below:
