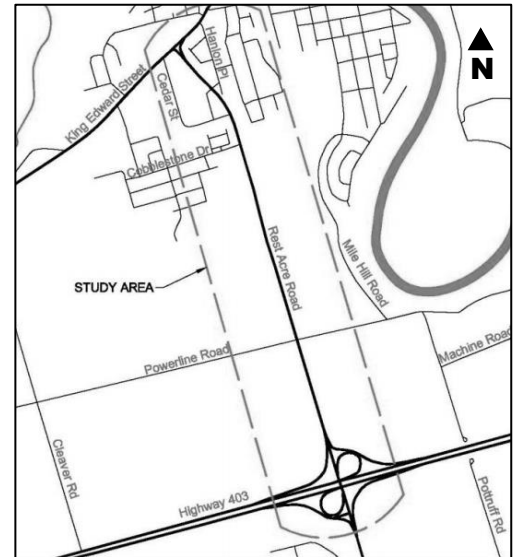
NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

HARMONIZED PROVINCIAL AND MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT ADDENDUM FOR REST ACRES ROAD CORRIDOR FROM HIGHWAY 403 TO KING EDWARD STREET

The County of Brant has completed a Harmonized Transportation Facility and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Addendum to document amendments to:

- Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Powerline Road (2016);
- Class Environmental Assessment for Rest Acres Road from King Edward Street to Highway 403, Paris (2012); and
- Proposed Operational Improvements at Rest Acres Road/Highway 24 and Highway 403 Harmonized Environmental Screening Document/Project File (2017).

The purpose of the Class EA Addendum is to define the corridor vision and preliminary design plan of Rest Acres Road between Highway 403 and King Edward Street. The Addendum meets the requirements under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2015), Schedule C undertaking and the Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities (2000), Group B undertaking.



As a part of this update, several refinements to the previous studies are proposed including:

- Changes to the geometric design (roundabout geometry, sidewalks, and medians);
- Localized operational improvements at Edgar Place;
- Addition of a future roundabout at Pit Haul Road between Highway 403 and Powerline Road; and
- Potential future changes to the access at Vic Chambers Place and at 1084 Rest Acres Road.

As a Group B and Schedule C project, a Harmonized Environmental Study Report (ESR) Addendum has been completed and is available for review at: County of Brant Administration Office, 26 Park Avenue, Burford; Paris Customer Service Office, 66 Grand River Street North, Paris; and the Brant Sports Complex, 944 Powerline Road, Paris, during regular business hours as well as online at <http://www.brant.ca/>

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

If there are any concerns regarding the project that cannot be resolved in discussion with the County, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which Addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. Requests with reasons may be received by the Minister and Director of the Environmental Approvals Branch of the MOECC (at the addresses noted below) within 30 days of this notice, prior to March 17, 2018. A copy of the request and reasons must be sent to the County Capital Project Manager and the County of Brant Clerk's Office (contact information below). If there are no requests received within the 30 day review period, the project will receive environmental clearance. Subsequently, the project may proceed to design and construction, dependent on available funding.
