

DO YOU NEED HELP FILING YOUR TAXES?



If you are a low-income household and need to file your 2021 taxes, The Salvation Army Community and Family Services office in Paris can assist you.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, the Income Tax Clinics will look different this year. You will be required to gather all documents and put them into a folder and drop them off to our location (25 B Dundas Street West.) We are open Monday's and Thursday's from 1-3 PM (with the exception of holidays.)

There is also a mail slot in the door that you can drop your documents into at our location.

IF YOU ARE DROPPING YOUR TAX INFO OFF INTO THE MAIL SLOT, PLEASE ENSURE ALL HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS NAMES ARE INCLUDED INSIDE, ALONG WITH DATES OF BIRTH, SOCIAL INSURANCE NUMBERS AND CONTACT INFORMATION.

Once your taxes have been filed , we will call you to pick up your personal documents. There is no cost to this program. **Eligibility may vary.** To qualify for these services, the maximum household income of each client will be reviewed.

Documents or items you may need to include are:

- All income slips for 2021
- Rent/property tax paid for 2021 (including address, postal code, and name of Landlord if rent was paid)
 - T4, T4A, T5 & T5007 slips
 - RRSP Contributions
- Receipts for medical, dental and/or child care.
 - T2202A Slip for Education/tuition

Documents may be applicable to individuals on a case-by-case basis. Further documents or items may be required.
