

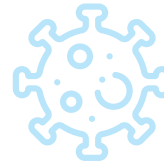
How to use **Brant Transit**

Looking to schedule a ride with Brant Transit using a device?

Follow the easy steps below!

1. Download the Brant Transit App on your smartphone or visit brant.ca/Transit
2. Create an account and log-in
3. Enter your pick-up and drop-off locations
4. Choose a date and time
5. Include number of passengers riding with you and confirm
6. Choose your payment option – riders can pay online with a credit card or opt to pay cash at time of pick-up. Brant Transit punch cards can also be used.
7. Arrive on time at your pick-up location
8. Look for the Brant Transit logo on the vehicle and say hello to your friendly Brant Transit driver
9. Sit back and enjoy the ride!

Brant Transit strives to keep all passengers and drivers as safe as possible during the COVID-19 pandemic.

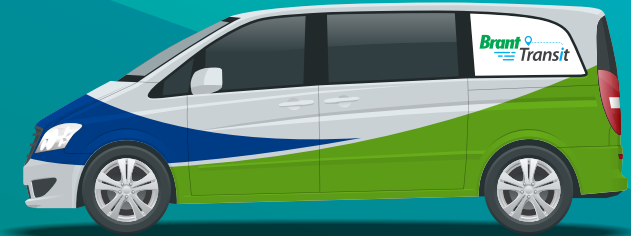
- All high contact touch points are disinfected after every passenger and all vehicles are fully disinfected every evening.

What is Brant Transit?



Brant Transit is a **public transportation program**.

This service includes a fleet of vans ready to help residents with their transportation needs. This is not the same as a taxi or an Uber as rides and routes are shared with other users.



Brant Transit is a **shared ride service**.

'Shared ride service' means that you will likely be sharing your ride with other riders and there may be multiple stops on the way to your destination. We encourage riders to book at least 24 hours in advance to secure your ride.



Brant Transit is **accessible**.

Be sure to let us know if you require any accommodation or are travelling with a mobility device at the time of booking. Please also advise if you have a support person travelling with you at the time of booking.



Brant Transit is **cost effective**.

The flat fee for a one-way trip costs \$5, seniors (55+) are \$3, children (12 and under) and support persons are free. Children (12 and under) must be accompanied by an adult at all times.



Brant Transit can **get you there**.

Brant Transit transports riders:

- Anywhere in the County of Brant
- Going from the County of Brant to the City of Brantford
- Going from the City of Brantford to the County of Brant

Fees:

General Rate:	\$5.00 per person
Seniors: (55 years of age and older)	\$3.00 per person
Children: (12 years of age and under) <i>Children must travel with an adult.</i>	FREE
Support Person <i>Must be accompanied by the individual who you are supporting</i>	FREE
