### INFORMATION

This application shall be considered approved and shall act as a Permit only when signed by an authorized member of the County of Brant indicating approval of the alteration of grade as per the information supplied in this application. Any proposed modifications to an existing approved Site Alteration application must be reviewed and approved by Staff prior to implementation.

Any modifications made to the elements deemed to be significantly different from the approved application or which contravene By-law 130-17 shall invalidate this Permit.

Invalidation of the Permit will require the applicant to re-apply for a new Permit, and/or will require removal of all project elements from the public right-of-way. The County of Brant has the right to remove elements from the public right-of-way which differ from the approved application and/or pose a safety hazard to the general public.

**This permit shall only be valid within the Permit period as noted to a maximum of one (1) year.**
