### **Regarding: County of Brant entering Orange – Restrict Zone**

On **Tuesday, February 16, 2021 at 12:01 am**, following the Government of Ontario's announcement, the County of Brant is set to transition from the shutdown measures that were put in place on December 26, 2020 to a revised and strengthened [COVID-19 Response Framework: Keeping Ontario Safe and Open](#) (the "Framework").

In consultation with public health officials, Brant will reopen in the Orange – Restrict Zone.

As a result, the following County of Brant service level changes will occur.

#### **Customer Service:**

- The County of Brant will reopen Customer Service Offices in Paris and Burford on **Tuesday, February 16, 2021**.
- Regular hours will resume, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.
  - Burford Customer Service Office (26 Park Avenue, Burford)
  - Paris Customer Service Officer (66 Grand River Street North, Paris)
