TESTING - Volunteer Firefighter Aptitude Test and Physical Fitness Test

Qualified candidates must take a Volunteer Firefighter Aptitude Test and participate in Physical Testing

Once screening process is complete the successful candidate will be enrolled in a mandatory recruit training program (JTAG), held during evenings and weekend, and a 12 month probationary period.
