

By-Law 182-05

The County of Brant's By-law 182-05 restricts heavy truck traffic from travelling through the community of Paris, south of Silver Street and north of King Edward Street/Dundas Street East. The By-law also prohibits heavy trucks from travelling on select roads within Burford including Alexander Street, Rutherford Street and West Andrew Street .

Why is it important to restrict heavy truck routes within the County of Brant?

- Supports safe and timely movement of goods and services.
- Recognizes and tries to limit the impacts of truck traffic on the interests of the greater community such as safety, congestion, noise, and air quality.
- Protects the County's road infrastructure that cannot bear heavy loads or roads where truck traffic would be unsuitable (e.g. narrow lanes, weight restrictions on bridges).

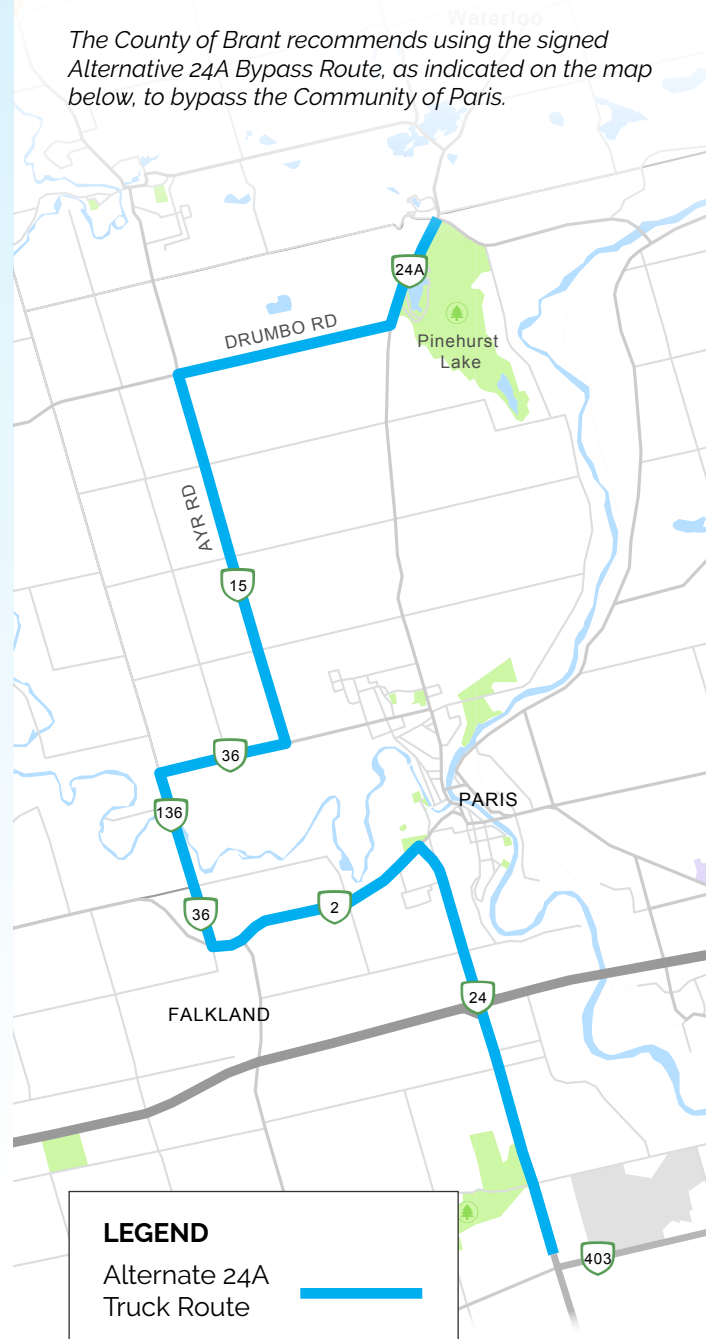
Enforcement
