Interested in becoming a Snow Buddy?

Snow Buddies help seniors/adults by shoveling snow.

This is an important service to your community because you are helping seniors to continue to live independently in their own homes.

Buddies must be 12 years of age or older.

Buddies can choose to volunteer their time **or** be paid for the work they have done. New Buddies are required to complete the orientation package and quiz before you can begin shoveling snow.

Adults (18 +) are also welcome however they do require a police check.

Please call 519.442.1818 to obtain a "Request for Police Check" letter in the mail. There is no fee to receive a volunteer police check.

We **must** have the police check before we can match you with a senior.

If you would like to register and become a new Snow Buddy, please call 519.442.1818 or email recprograms@brant.ca to request that a registration package be mailed to you. **Please remember that a match cannot be guaranteed.**

The ability to match seniors/adults and Buddies depends on the number of people who register and where they live in relationship to each other.
