

**BY-LAW NUMBER 142-99**

- of -

**THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT**

Being a by-law to prohibit the use of skateboards on the sidewalks, boulevards, and municipal parking lots in the Business Improvement Area of the Paris Service Area.

**WHEREAS** Section 207(42) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990 permits the municipality to pass a by-law prohibiting vehicles and conveyances of every description from being upon or being used or propelled upon any sidewalk set apart for pedestrian use, or upon any highway or boulevard;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 207(56) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990 authorizes the establishment of parking lots and the regulation of vehicles therein;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the County of Brant deems it necessary and expedient to pass a by-law prohibiting skateboards from being used upon the sidewalks, boulevards, and parking lots within the Business Improvement Area in the Paris Service Area of the County of Brant;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF BRANT HEREBY ENACTS as follows:**

**1. Short Title:**

This by-law shall be cited as the "Skateboard" By-law.

**2. Definitions**

2.1 Highway means a common or public highway as defined in Section 261 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, or any part thereof, and includes any sidewalks, boulevards, or other areas between the lateral property lines thereof.

2.2 Municipal Parking Lot means land under control of the municipality which has been improved for the parking of vehicles.

2.3 Sidewalk means a portion of the highway improved for pedestrian use.

2.4 Skateboard means a platform on wheels, commonly known as a skateboard, which is driven or propelled by muscular power and which shall be deemed to be a vehicle for the purpose of this by-law.

**3. Skateboarding in Parking Lots and on Sidewalks Prohibited**

No person shall use a skateboard within any municipal parking lot or upon any sidewalk or other portion of the highway used by or set apart for use by pedestrians or set apart for ornament or embellishment, within the area set out in 'Schedule A' attached.

**4. Penalty**

Any person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to any penalty imposed pursuant to The Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990.

**5. Enforcement**

Officers employed by the Brant County Police Service and Municipal Law Enforcement Officers appointed by the County of Brant are hereby authorized to enforce the provisions of this by-law.

**6. Enactment**

This by-law comes into force and takes effect on the date of passage hereof.

**7. Repeal**

That By-law Number 127-99 is hereby repealed.

**READ** a first and second time, this 20th day of July, 1999.

**READ** a third time and finally passed in Council, this 20th day of July, 1999.
