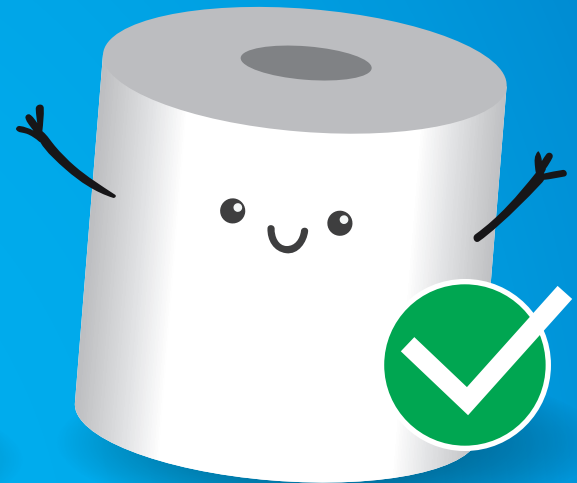


We all have a responsibility
to **keep our sewers clean.**

In order to keep your household sewer pipes and the County of Brant's sewer system flowing smoothly, it's important to remember to only flush the 3 P's: Pee, Poop and toilet Paper and not to drain liquids down sinks/drains that could cause blockages or impact the condition of the sewers.

*** It's important to only flush the 3 P's:
Pee, Poop and Toilet Paper**



Please **do not**
flush wipes

Even wipes labeled as "flushable" are made of materials that don't break down in the sewer.



*Think before
you flush...*

Flushing anything other than pee, poo and toilet paper can result in clogging your plumbing and the sanitary equipment, such as pumps and screens. This increases maintenance costs and could cause sewer backups.

Please **do not flush:**

- ❌ Wipes (including "flushable" wipes)
- ❌ Paper towels / Napkins
- ❌ Socks / Clothing
- ❌ Dental floss
- ❌ Condoms
- ❌ Food scraps
- ❌ Fats/oils/grease
- ❌ Paint, Chemicals
- ❌ Medication
- ❌ Feminine hygiene products
