<b>Fire Watch / Scene Security</b>

<b>Third Party Costs</b>			
Costs paid to third parties by the County of Brant as part of or as a result of a fire response. Examples may include but not limited to are heavy or specialized equipment, technical expertise, fire agents, removal or clean up	extra	each	Cost recovery + 15% administrative charge on third party costs
<b>Smoke Alarms</b>			
Providing and / or installing a Smoke Alarm	extra	each	Cost Recovery
<b>Carbon Monoxide Alarms</b>			
Providing and / or installing a Carbon Monoxide Alarm	extra	each	Cost Recovery
<b>Nuisance Deployment</b>			
Fire Department responding to a Nuisance complaint or incident	exempt	each	Current rate dictated by MTO rate structure
<b>Reinspection</b>			
<i>Inspection for compliance</i>

<b>Fire Works Violation</b>			
Failure to comply with the Fireworks Bylaw 19-23 (as amended by 86-24 & 62-25)	extra	each	Current rate dictated by MTO rate structure
