About Us

Paramedics are highly trained medical professionals who are able to provide a range of home-based services, focusing on certain health conditions. Community paramedics work with your healthcare team and community services to provide the care and services you need. You can be assessed and treated in the comfort of your home, removing barriers and connecting you with services when and where you need them. There is **NO COST** for any of our services, all funding is provided by various provincial agencies and ministries.



Wellness Clinics

Community paramedics host scheduled wellness clinics within identified adult lifestyle and city/county housing complexes. We provide health assessments, and some medical tasks. We consult with your care providers about your overall health and well-being. Information may be provided about medication management and ways you can improve your health and wellness.

We can also connect you with other community resources, helping to reduce barriers to accessing care.

In-Home Services

Community paramedics can help you with in-home assessment and treatment services. Focusing on assisting you with managing your chronic disease such as COPD, CHF, and others. We can provide a range of treatments and tests including injectable medications, vaccinations, change diabetic blood glucose sensors, bloodwork for homebound clients, urinalysis, urine cultures, assist you with medication management, monitor your vitals or help you connect with other care services you need.

Community Paramedic Long-term Care (CPLTC)

This program is funded by the ministry of long-term care with the goal of allowing residents to remain in their own homes if they wish and are able. Community paramedics will provide scheduled visits during the day and remain available 24/7 for non-emergency issues and requests for assistance from the patient and/or caregiver via phone or possible visit. Tools to assist with caregiver burnout are taught and referrals provided. Patients receive assessment, treatment, education and referral. The same treatments and tests available for in-home services are available. This program relies on a professional working collaboration with Home and Community Care Support Services, healthcare professionals, and community resources. This program does not register or place clients into long-term care.

Remote Monitoring

If you have congestive heart failure (CHF) or COPD and have had multiple emergency room visits or hospitalizations, you may benefit from our remote home monitoring program.

We provide all the equipment and in-home services **free of charge** and work with your healthcare team to monitor changes in your health remotely. When changes are detected, we provide the help you need before it leads to an emergency.
